
Laser Printer Precautions

This printer uses laser technology. The following list of precautions applies whenever you open the printer cover. Even if you are familiar with other types of printers, be sure to follow these precautions carefully to ensure safe, efficient operation:

☐ Do not touch the areas specified on the caution labels inside cover A and cover B. If the printer has been in use, the fuser can be very hot.



- ☐ Avoid touching the components inside the printer unless instructed to do so in this guide.
- ☐ Never force the printer's components into place. Although the printer is designed to be sturdy, rough handling can damage it.
- ☐ Be sure not to scratch the surface of the drum. When you remove the imaging cartridge from the printer, always set the unit on a clean, smooth surface. Also, avoid touching the drum, since oil from your skin can permanently damage its surface and may affect print quality.
- ☐ Do not turn the cartridge upside down or stand it on its ends.
- ☐ Protect the light-sensitive drum from exposure to light. Avoid exposing the imaging cartridge to room light any longer than necessary. Do not open the drum's protective cover. Overexposing the drum may cause abnormally dark or light areas to appear on the printed page and reduce the service life of the drum.



- ☐ When handling the cartridge, always set it on a clean, smooth surface.
- ☐ Do not attempt to modify or take the cartridge apart. It cannot be refilled.

		Do not touch the toner and avoid all contact with your eyes.		
		Wait for at least one hour before using an imaging cartridge after moving it from a cool to a warm environment to prevent damage from condensation.		
		Warning: Do not dispose of used imaging cartridges in fire, as they can explode and cause injury. Dispose of them according to local regulations.		
		To get the best print quality, do not store the imaging cartridge in an area subject to direct sunlight, dust, salty air, or corrosive gases (such as ammonia). Avoid locations subject to extreme or rapid changes in temperature or humidity.





Attaching the Quick Reference Box

Use the quick reference box for storing the *Quick Reference* if this guide is included with your printer. Insert the knob on the bottom of the quick reference box into the slot on the left side of the printer. Then attach the quick reference box by inserting the knobs into the slots on each side.

Attaching the Side Cover


Attach the printer's side cover unless the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit is installed.

Follow these steps to attach the printer's side cover:



If the optional 500-sheet Lower Cassette Unit is installed, attach the side cover to the lowermost 500-sheet Lower Cassette Unit.

1. Remove the side cover from the box and confirm the direction in which it is to be attached.




2. Attach the side cover to the bottom of the printer by first fitting the side cover into the slot to the rear of the printer, then fitting the other end into the slot to the front.



Installing the Imaging Cartridge

Follow these steps to install the imaging cartridge:


1. While holding the imaging cartridge horizontally, gently rock it back and forth a few times to distribute the toner evenly.





Caution:


- Do not turn the imaging cartridge upside down.
- Do not open the drum's protective cover and avoid exposing the imaging cartridge to room light any longer than necessary. Overexposing the cartridge may cause abnormally dark or light areas to appear on the printed page and reduce the service life of the cartridge.




2. To release the spring-loaded carrying handles on the sides of the new cartridge, hold down each handle with your hand and remove the tape that is affixed to the handle. Release the handle by removing your hand from it gently and the handle will automatically spring out.




When you remove the tape, the handle may spring out quickly enough to hurt your fingers. To avoid this, hold the handle firmly in position while peeling off the tape.




3. Open cover A gently by pulling the latch.







Do not touch the hot areas indicated by caution labels inside cover A.



4. Holding the left and right handles of the imaging cartridge, insert it into the printer until it is firmly seated.



5. Close cover A by pushing it up and into the printer.

500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit


It is best to install the optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit (C81319*) when first setting up the printer. You can install up to two optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Units, or one optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit plus the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit.

Please note that you will need the assistance of at least two other people to lift up the printer when installing this option.

Follow these steps to install the optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit:


- 1. Open the shipping carton.
- 2. Remove the inserts and all other protective materials inside the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included documentation. Remove the packaging materials and any other items from the 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit and store them for future use.
- 3. Lift the unit out of the box and place it near the printer.

If you plan to install more than one 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit, stack the cassettes with the front of each cassette facing the same direction.




If you plan to install the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit at the same time, refer to the instructions under "Large Capacity Paper Unit" on page 18 to complete the installation of both units.

4. Remove the side cover from the bottom of the printer.



5. With the assistance of two or more people, grasp the printer at the positions indicated below and lift it carefully.









Large Capacity Paper Unit

It is best to install the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit (C81322*) when first setting up the printer. Please note that you will need the assistance of at least two other people to lift up the printer when installing this option.

Follow these steps to install the optional Large Capacity Paper Unit:


- 1. Open the shipping carton.
- 2. Remove the inserts and all other protective materials inside the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included documentation. Remove the packaging materials and any other items from the unit and store them for future use.

3. With the assistance of two or more people, lift the Large Capacity Paper Unit out of the box and place it near the printer.



The unit has four handles that you can use to lift it with. Pull the handles out from the locations shown below when you need to use them.



4. You will find three casters at the bottom of the Large Capacity Paper Unit. Lock the casters by pushing their levers down.



Duplex Unit

Installing the optional Duplex Unit (C81318*) allows you to automatically print on both sides of the paper.



- Remove the inserts and all other protective materials inside the box. Make sure the contents of the package match the items on the included documentation. Remove the packaging materials and any other items from the unit and store them for future use.



Memory Module

The printer comes with 16 MB of memory. By installing an optional Dual In-line Memory Module (DIMM), you can increase printer memory up to a maximum of 256 MB. You may want to add memory if you are having difficulty printing complex, graphics-intensive pages using one of the optional multibin units with the duplex feature, or if you regularly use numerous downloaded fonts.

You can purchase DIMMs from various vendors. Be sure the DIMM you purchase meets the following requirements:

- ☐ Synchronous Dynamic RAM Dual In-line Memory Module (SDRAM DIMM)
- ☐ 64 bit, 168-pin type, with SPD
- Capacity of 16, 32, 64, 128, or 256 MB
- ☐ Access speed of 66.66 MHz or higher (15 ns or less)
- ☐ Less than 40 mm in height


4. Place the unit on top of the printer. Be careful not to drop the unit.




5. Fasten the screw on the front of the unit.



6. Fasten the screw on the back of the unit, then attach the cable to the connector on the back of the printer.






8. Insert the tray shown below into Bin 1. (The tray has the number 1 printed on the top right corner). Please note that this tray differs in shape from the trays for the other bins.






11. Open the back cover of the unit and remove all protective materials.

10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit

The optional 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit (C81321*) can be used as a mailbox, a sorter, a multiple sorter, or a large capacity stacker. The output capacity is 2,000 printed sheets of plain paper.


Follow these steps to install the optional 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit:

- 1. Open the shipping carton.
- 2. Unpack the unit from the top and remove the contents.


Note:

The 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit itself is heavy, so you will need the assistance of at least one person to lift the inner box containing the unit out of the carton, and to remove the unit from the inner box.

3. Attach the two metal plates to the left side of the printer with the included fittings and screws, as shown below.




Attach the lower support clamp to the bottom of the printer as shown. Press up on the clamp until it clicks into place.




Open the cover on the back side of the 10-Bin Multi-Purpose 5. Unit and remove the protective materials inside.

6. Insert one end of the lower support bar into the lower support clamp on the printer and the other end into the lower support clamp on the 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit.




Then roll the 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit toward the printer until the magnets on the unit make contact with the metal plates.


7. Tighten the screw at the bottom of the unit to secure the lower support bar.




8. Remove the stickers from the holes on the face-down tray, then attach the lower paper guide as shown below.






10. Attach the cables from the 10-Bin Multi-Purpose Unit to the printer and the paper guide as shown below.



11. Insert the output trays into the unit, starting from the bottom. All the trays are of the same shape.



12. If you need to adjust the height of the unit, remove the cover on the front wheel first, then turn the front screws to the left. Turn the top screw to adjust the height of the unit, then turn the front screws to the right to secure the top screw. Replace the front wheel cover.




Plugging in the Printer

Attaching the Power Cord

Follow these steps to plug the printer into an electrical outlet:

- 1. Make sure the power switch on the front of the printer is turned off.
- 2. Insert the power cord into the AC inlet at the back of the printer, then plug the other end into a properly grounded outlet.

- Only use an outlet that meets the power requirements of this printer.

Loading Paper

This section provides you with instructions for loading paper into the MP tray and the standard lower cassette.

Note:

The printer also supports an optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit, which uses the same loading method as the standard lower cassette.

Loading paper into the MP tray

The MP tray can accommodate various types and sizes of paper and envelopes. It handles 250 sheets of plain paper, allowing you to load a total of 750 sheets when used in combination with the lower cassette.

You can load the following paper sizes. The loading orientation differs depending on the paper size, as explained below:


Loading Orientation	Paper Size
Vertical	A4, A5, Executive, Letter, B5, G-Letter, HLT
Horizontal	A3, Ledger, Legal, B4, F4, G-Legal, Monarch, Commercial 10, DL, C5, C6, International B5


When you load Executive, G-Letter, HLT, Ledger, B4, G-Legal, and other custom paper sizes, select the paper size in the printer driver, then set the paper size for the MP tray using the SelecType Tray Menu. For instructions, see "SelecType Settings" in the Reference Guide.

Follow these steps to load paper into the MP tray:


1. Pull out the paper cassette and remove the protective materials inside.




2. Push down the inner tray until it clicks onto the bottom of the cassette.



3. While pressing the vertical and horizontal paper guides, pull them up and slide them outward to accommodate the paper you are loading.




4. Fan a stack of paper and tap it on a flat surface to even the edges, then insert the paper into the cassette with the printable side facing up.



Note:

- □ Be sure not to load paper higher than the maximum paper mark.
- ☐ If your printouts are curled or do not stack properly when using plain paper, try turning the stack over and reloading it.


5. Adjust the vertical and horizontal paper guides to match the size of your paper.





Make sure to adjust the paper guides to the paper size you load; otherwise, the printer will not print properly.

6. Push the paper cassette in.



7. Peel the appropriate paper size label from the label sheet included with your printer and attach it to the outside of the MP tray.



Loading paper into the lower cassette


The lower cassette can accommodate a variety of paper sizes. It handles 500 sheets of plain paper, allowing you to load a total of 750 sheets when used in combination with the MP tray.

You can load the following paper sizes. The loading orientation differs depending on the paper size, as explained below:


Loading Orientation	Paper Size
Vertical	A4, Letter, Government Letter
Horizontal	A3, Ledger, Legal, B4

Follow these steps to load paper into the lower cassette, or into an optional 500-Sheet Lower Cassette Unit:


1. Pull the paper cassette all the way out, and remove the protective materials inside.




2. Push down the inner tray until it clicks onto the bottom of the cassette.




3. While pressing the vertical paper guide, pull it up and slide it outward to accommodate the paper you are loading.



4. Insert the horizontal paper guide into the slot for the paper size you want to load.




5. Fan a stack of paper and tap it on a flat surface to even the edges. Insert the paper with the printable side facing up, aligning the corners of the paper with the metal retaining clips inside the cassette.




- Be sure not to load paper higher than the maximum paper mark.
- ☐ If your printouts are curled or do not stack properly when using plain paper, try turning the stack over and reloading it.
- ☐ Make sure to adjust the paper guides to match the paper size you load; otherwise, the printer will not print properly.
- 6. Set the paper size with the paper-size dial.



7. Push the paper cassette in.



8. Peel the appropriate paper size label from the label sheet included with your printer and attach it to the outside of the cassette.



Selecting the paper size

By default, the printer driver is set for A4 size paper. If you load paper of a different size, change the Paper Size setting on the printer driver's Basic Settings tab. For more information on using the printer driver, see the driver's online help.

You can also change this setting from the printer's control panel by using OneTouch mode 1. For details, see "Using the OneTouch Modes" in the *Reference Guide*.

Testing the Printer


To test if the printer is properly set up, print a status sheet. You can print a status sheet directly by using the SelecType menus on the printer's control panel. The status sheet contains information on the current printer settings and all installed options. Printing a status sheet is an effective way of testing the printer because it eliminates the possibility of connection problems with the computer.

Printing a status sheet


Follow these steps to print a status sheet from the control panel:

- 1. Make sure the imaging cartridge is installed.
- 2. Make sure that paper is loaded into the printer.

3. Turn on the printer. Several messages will appear on the LCD panel as the printer performs internal tests. After about 10 seconds, the Ready message will appear.



- 4. Make sure the On Line light is on. This indicates that the printer is ready to accept and print data. If it isn't on, press the On Line button.
- 5. Press Enter two times. The printer will print the status sheet, showing the current printer settings.



Connecting the Printer to a Computer

Although this printer is intended to be used on a network, you can use the parallel interface to connect the printer directly to a computer.



Follow these steps to connect the printer to your computer through the parallel interface:


- 1. Make sure both the printer and the computer are turned off.
- 2. Connect the parallel cable to the parallel interface connector on the printer.

Note:

Use only a shielded, twisted-pair parallel cable.



3. Secure the connector by pushing the two wire clips together until they lock into place on both sides of the connector. If your cable has a ground wire, connect it to the printer's ground connector as shown below.



- 4. Connect the other end of the cable to your computer, and fasten it as required. If the cable has a ground wire at the computer end, attach it to the ground connector at the back of the computer.
- 5. Turn on the printer, then turn on your computer.
